ID AYU0052) with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 74 Seats (instead 76 seats) in 12 PG course in subject namely (i) Dravyaguna Vigyana-05 seats (ii)Rasa Shastra & Bhasajya Kalpana- 11 seats (iii) Agad Tantra avum Vidhi Vaidyaka-06 seats (iv) Kaumarbhritya -BalaRoga -06 seats (v) Kayachikitsa -05 seats (instead of 06 seats)(vi) Kayachikitsa-Rasayan & Vajikaran -05 seats (instead of 06 seats) (vii) Panchakarma -06 seats (viii) Shalya Tantra -06 seats (ix)Shalakyata -06 seats (x) Swasthavritta -06 seats (xi) Rog Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan - 06 seats (xii)Prasuti & Stri Roga-06 seats for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act,1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

1. This is with reference to your first appeal filed by the Principal, **Shri B.M. Kankanadi Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya, Shahapur, Belgaum- 590003, Karnataka vide ref. no. BMK/2024-25/660 dated 24.06.2024 to the Commission in respect of Conditional Permission with seat reduction of 02 seats in PG Kayachikitsa i.e. Kayachikitsa -04 seats (instead of 06 seats), Kayachikitsa-Rasayan & Vajikaran -06 seats, instead to consider to reduce 01 seat in respective PG speciality i.e. 01 seat in Kayachikitsa and 01 seat in Kayachikitsa- Rasayana Vajikarna has been received in the Commission against the letter from the Board vide ref. No.- 4-7/KA/MARB/2024-25 Ay dated: 21.06.2024 passed by President MARBISM for the academic session 2024-25 due to non-fulfillment of the basic eligibility criteria in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (The Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016" and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder and other shortcoming as mentioned in the Conditional Permission vide letter of even number dated 21.06.2024.**
2. Thereafter the said appeal was placed before the Chairman, NCISM and the Chairman NCISM constituted a Hearing Committee to provide an opportunity of hearing to the aforementioned college. Accordingly, the letter was sent to the college vide Commission's letter dated **04.07.2024** to appear before the designated hearing committee as constituted by the Chairman, NCISM on **05.07.2024** to consider the appeal filed by **the Principal Shri B.M. Kankanadi Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya, Shahapur, Belgaum- 590003, Karnataka** in respect of **Conditional Permission with seat reduction of 02 seats in PG Kayachikitsa i.e. Kayachikitsa -04 seats (instead of 06 seats), Kayachikitsa-Rasayan & Vajikaran -06 seats, instead to consider to reduce 01 seat in respective PG speciality i.e. 01 seats in Kayachikitsa and 01 seat in Kayachikitsa- Rasayana Vajikarna**, filed under section 10(1)(g) and section 24(3) of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020 and to produce all relevant valid documents/records/ proof to substantiate the claims and make written submission and submit an authenticated copy of evidence/verifications to commission with shortcoming wise clarifications mentioned in the Permission letter dated 21.06.2024 passed by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM. The proceedings of appeal were held virtually on **05.07.2024 at 10:30 AM** and on behalf of the college, **Dr. Suhas Kumar Shetty, Principal of Shri B.M. Kankanawadi Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Shahapur, Belgaum- 590003, Karnataka (Inst. Id.- AYU0052)** attended the hearing.
3. The hearing committee sought clarification from **Dr. Suhas Kumar Shetty, Principal of Shri B.M. Kankanawadi Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Shahapur, Belgaum- 590003, Karnataka (Inst. Id.- AYU0052)** regarding the Conditional Permission issued by Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM, vide letter of even number dated 21.06.2024 which is as under:-

Rasayana Vajikarana- 06 seats				As per regulation 16,(1) & (2) of IMCC (Post Graduate Ayurvedic Education) regulations, 2016, the teacher-student ratio shall be such that the number of post-graduate teachers to the number of post-graduate students admitted per year is maintained as 1:3 in case of Professor and 1:2 in case of Reader or Associate Professor. The teacher student ratio shall be 1:1 in case of Lecturer or Assistant Professor having minimum of five years teaching experience. Hence, the college is fulfilling for 10 seats (instead of 12 seats). Committee recommended 05 seats in Kayachikitsa and 05 seats in Kayachikitsa- Rasayana Vajikarana for PG course.

4. The submissions made by **Dr. Suhas Kumar Shetty, Principal of Shri B.M. Kankanawadi Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Shahapur, Belgaum- 590003, Karnataka (Inst. Id.- AYU0052)** and observations of the hearing committee was placed before the Chairman, NCISM and it has been decided by the Chairman NCISM to consider the appeal filed by Principal of **Shri B.M. Kankanawadi Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Shahapur, Belgaum- 590003, Karnataka (Inst. Id.- AYU0052),** received in the commission in respect of conditional permission with seat reduction of 02 seats in PG Kayachikitsa, instead to considered to reduce 01 seat in respective PG speciality i.e. 01 seats in Kayachikitsa and 01 seat in Kayachikitsa- Rasayana Vajikarna for the academic year 2024-25.
5. Hence, in compliance of the direction received in the letter no. NCISM/Comm./OPT Appeal/(2024-25)dated **16.07.2024,** it has been decided by the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM to issue Conditional Permission to **Karnataka Liberal Education University, Shri B.M. Kankanadi Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya, Shahapur, Belgaum- 590003, Karnataka (Inst. ID AYU0052)** in respect of conditional permission with seat reduction of 02 seats in PG Kayachikitsa, instead to considered to reduce 01 seat in respective PG speciality i.e. 01 seats in Kayachikitsa and 01 seat in Kayachikitsa- Rasayana Vajikarna for the academic year 2024-25 and relevant regulations thereunder. The permission process for issuance of Conditional permission to **Karnataka Liberal Education University, Shri B.M. Kankanadi Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya, Shahapur, Belgaum- 590003, Karnataka (Inst. ID AYU0052)** with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 74 Seats (instead 76 seats) in 12 PG course in subject namely (i) Dravyaguna Vigyana-05 seats (ii)Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana- 11 seats (iii) Agad Tantra avum Vidhi Vaidyaka-06 seats (iv) Kaumarbhritya -BalaRoga -06 seats (v) Kayachikitsa -05 seats (instead of 06 seats)(vi) Kayachikitsa-Rasayan & Vajikaran -05 seats (instead of 06 seats) (vii) Panchakarma -06 seats (viii) Shalya Tantra -06 seats (ix)Shalakra tantra-06 seats (x) Swasthavritta -06 seats (xi) Rog Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan - 06 seats (xii)Prasuti & Stri Roga-06 seats for the academic year 2024-25 under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder
- (i) The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the colleges/hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant rules and regulations.
- (ii) It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with **100 seats UG** and minimum 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of **74 seats in 12 PG courses** shall be treated as All India Quota. The counseling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of that State/UT. **The**

permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for All India Quota or the students admitted thereunder.

(iii) It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no.BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.

6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
7. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MABISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
8. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
9. **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2024 and compliance report should be sent to get permission for the academic session 2025-2026:**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.
 - ii) All the requirements of minimum standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in MES (Assessment & Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022.
 - iv) The shortcoming mentioned in **Para no. 3** above, should be fulfilled.
10. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2025-26.
